VULCAN COUNTY Farming of Road Allowances Policy

The County shall not lease out any road allowances for any purpose.

USED ROAD ALLOWANCES

- 1. All landowners within Vulcan County may farm adjoining road allowances to the toe of the shoulder of the road. The said road allowances may be developed for any purpose at any time of the year and such development is the responsibility of Vulcan County. Any damage to crop, fence or any other things located on the said road allowance is strictly the responsibility of the adjacent landowner.
- 2. Free access must be maintained to all surveyed road allowances within Vulcan County.
- 3. All utilities placed on Vulcan County road allowances shall be at a distance of .60 metres (2 feet) within the County property at the discretion of Vulcan County or its approved authority. All power lines will be placed at maximum of .60 meters (2 feet) and all communications lines will be ploughed in at the toe of the backslope to a minimum depth of 3 feet.
- 4. All such placements may be appealed to Vulcan County and may be suspended at any time without notice.

UNUSED ROAD ALLOWANCES

- 1. All landowners within Vulcan County may farm all unused road allowances within the said County adjoining their land. All such farming will be allowed as long as there is no dispute with any other adjoining landowner over the same piece of road allowance. All disputes will be heard at the Vulcan County Council meetings and their decision will be final.
- 2. Free access must be maintained to all surveyed road allowances within Vulcan County.

- 3. All utilities placed within the Vulcan County road allowance shall be placed at .60 metres (2 feet) within County Property or at the discretion of Vulcan County and/or its approved representative. All communications lines will be ploughed in at a minimum of 3 feet.
- 4. All such placements can be appealed to Vulcan County Council within thirty (30) days of notification of placement of said utility. All decisions of the said Council are final.
- 5. All privileges for the farming of the unused road allowance is at the discretion of Vulcan County and may be suspended without notice.
- 6. All costs for further movement of the said utility from the normal placement of said utility will be at the responsibility of the appealing party and Vulcan County.
