# VULCAN COUNTY <u>Texas Gate(s)</u>

- Anyone wishing to install a texas gate within a Vulcan County road allowance must comply with the following:
  - a) The applicant must complete and sign the 'Approval To Install a Texas Gate Within a Road Allowance Form' with Vulcan County prior to installation. This form must receive Vulcan County approval.
  - b) Texas gates shall be installed to Vulcan County standards and any specifications as set out in the approval form.
  - Subject to the availability of its equipment, Vulcan County will install the Texas gate with Vulcan County to be reimbursed for installation costs by the applicant.
  - d) The applicant may install the Texas gate provided that the installation meets all Vulcan County standards and specifications as set out in the approval form. If the Texas gate is not installed to Vulcan County standards and specifications, Vulcan County will remove the texas gate at the applicant's cost.
  - Maintenance of Texas gates and the cost for the maintenance shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
  - f) The County shall be responsible for maintenance of Texas gates on developed road allowances and all other Texas gates shall be the applicants responsibility for the maintenance and associated costs.
  - g) Vulcan County's standards for Texas gates are:
    - 1. A minimum of 8.5 metres in width on developed roads
    - A minimum of 7.3 metres in width on driveways
    - A minimum of 7.3 metres in width on resources roads
    - 4. A minimum of 7.3 metres in width on temporary approaches.
    - 5. Any other specifications as set out by Vulcan County in the Texas Gate approval form.
